



SMOKING POLICY

Peak Academy is an Independent school registered with the Western Cape Education Department (WCED) and with Cambridge Assessment International Education. Peak Academy is a division of Peak Group (PTY) Ltd.

Peak Academy does not endorse any student smoking any form of cigarette. This includes any form of electronic cigarettes.

We understand the law regarding the legal age of smoking, however Peak Academy will not provide any smoking areas for students on its premises. It is the responsibility of the parent to manage their child smoking and not Peak Academy's responsibility.

Students are not permitted to smoke during school academic hours.

This includes

1. Students are not permitted to smoke on any property of Peak Academy or partnered premises.
2. Students are not permitted to light a cigarette or smoke a cigarette or e- cigarette within 200 metres of a Peak Academy Premises.
3. This includes before school and after school
4. Students are not permitted to smoke cigarettes or e- cigarettes in any school bathroom.

Please note that should a student be found smoking Peak Academy reserves the right to confiscate any lighter, cigarette box, e-cigarette and any supplies related to the device. These items will not be returned to the student.

Students found not adhering to this policy will face disciplinary action in accordance with the disciplinary steps of the school. A student's Parents will be informed in writing of the incident. Repeated offences could result in the termination of a Parent's and student's contract with the Academy.
